Day 1: Manila—Istanbul
Overnight onboard.

Day 2: Istanbul - Izmir (L-D)

Upon arrival, meet with the local guide and drive to Pergamon, one of the finest archaeological site in Turkey. Here you will visit Acropolis Ancient site with cable car tour. Visit the Red Church of Pergamon or **Red Basilica** and **Theatira**, the home to a significant Christian church. Lunch buffet at the local restaurant and continue the journey to **Agora of Symirna** one of the Seven Churches that Apostle John relay the promise from God. Then proceed to Izmir port to enjoy the sunset. Dinner and Check-in at the hotel.

Day 3: Izmir—Kusadasi (B-L-D)

After breakfast, we will visit to **St. Polycarp** church, the oldest church in Izmir and represents the ancient Smyrna's role as one of the seven churches of Revelation. Then drive to Sardis, the ancient capital city of the Lydians and the visit to **Church of Sardis**. Continue to Alasehir where the ancient **Philadelphia Church** is located. After lunch, drive to Kusadasi and visit the House of Mary Later (or Meryem Ana Evi in Turkish) is a place where, according to the beliefs of many people Mary, the mother of Jesus, spent the last years of her life. Dinner and Check-in at the hotel.

Day 4: Kusadasi - Pumakkale (B-L-D)

After breakfast, visit the Leather Fashion House and enjoy a fashion show there with drinks served. Visit the premiere Greco-Roman City of ancient world, Ephesus. Explore the Temple of Hadrian, Domitian temple, famous Celsius Library, Great theatre and other Roman sites and then the **Basilica of St. John** (St. Jean Aniti), which was a great church in Ephesus constructed by Emperor Justinian in the 6th century. Lunch at local restaurant and drive to Pamukkale (Cotton Castle). Visit Hierapolis, the ruins of the biggest Necropolis (graveyard) of the ancient world, Roman Baths, Basilica and calcium cliffs next to the travertines. Afterwards proceed to the Laodicea Ancient site, one of the most successful commercial cities of its time in Asia Minor. Dinner and Overnight and enjoy a free hot spring bath in your hotel.

Day 5: Pumakkale—Konya—Cappadocia (B-L-D)

After breakfast, depart for Cappadocia via Konya, arrive Konya for lunch and visit the Caravansarai, a place for native traders. This buildings provide accommodation and other amenities for the merchants and stabling for their animals. Dinner and Check-in at the hotel.

Day 6: Cappadocia (B-L-D)

The region known in ancient times as Cappadocia is the setting for some of nature's most bizarre wonders. The unique and yet the strange rock formations and subterranean dwellings of Cappadocia provide unforgettable sets of experiences, memories and photographs. Visit the Turkish Carpet Factory with drinks served and continue the journey to the UNESCO listed World Heritage Site-Göreme Openair Museum. Lunch at local restaurant and continue to Underground Kaymakli, which is built by first Christian people to protect themselves from Romans during troubled times and are linked by underground tunnels to other cities. Proceed to Uchisar Hill and Pasabag to have a magnificent and unrivalled view of Cappadocia. Visit to Jewellery shop. Dinner and Check-in at the hotel.

Day 7: Cappadocia - Ankara (B-L-D)

After breakfast, depart for Ankara, the capital of Turkey and the country's second largest city after Istanbul. Along the way, we will stop at the Salt lake city and lunch at the local restaurant. Visit Atatürk Museum, resting place of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, the founder and first president of the Turkish Republic. Dinner and Check-in at the hotel.

Day 8: Ankara—Istanbul (B-L-D)

Depart for Istanbul, lunch on arrival, then visit the Blue Mosque continue to Hippodrome Square, former centre of sportive and political activities of Constantinople. Next to The Church of the Holy Wisdom-St. Sophia Church, is a former Eastern Orthodox. Visit to Spice Market. Enjoy the sunset thru the Bosphorus cruise, exploring the Strait at an unforgettable excursion starts between two continents, Europe and Asia. The cruise will take you along the Bosphorus, past the Europeans style palaces of the great Ottomans, Dolmabahce and Beylerbeyi, as well as the beautiful wooden kiosks of the 19th century, mansions and modern villas, which form the elegant sections of the city. Dinner and Check-in at the hotel.

Day 9: Istanbul (B-L-D)

Check out at the hotel after breakfast and enjoy the sightseeing tour of Istanbul. Visit to Topkapi Palace, built as official residence and the seat of government during Ottoman Empire. It is today a museum palace with a wide collection of Ottoman artifacts including imperial jewels, porcelain, armor and weapons. Chora church known for its intricate and stunning frescoes. With a history that goes back to the 4th century, the church witnessed many historical events that changed the city of old, Istanbul city. Lunch at local restaurant then continue city tour with Grand Bazaar, Taksim Square and Istiklat Street visit then bring you to Dinner and send to back to airport for the return flight to Manila.
